The University has now received the official individual assessment results for the 2018 Performance Based Research Fund from the Tertiary Education Commission.

The Commission has calculated both the aggregated and each individual Quality Category based on a peer reviewed comparative assessment of the selected publications, details of contribution to the research environment and the peer esteem factors presented in individual Evidence Portfolios.

The outcome of the review is that each staff member received a quality categorisation of A, B, C, C(NE), R or R(NE) under the PBRF framework.
